- Kandy is a large city in central Sri Lanka. It's set on a plateau surrounded by mountains. City is famed for sacred Buddhist sites, including the Temple of the Tooth (Sri Dalada Maligawa) shrine. This is the most holiest Buddhist temple in Sri Lanka making it the most sacred places of worship among Buddhists around the world.
- Kandy is in the bucket list of many tourists visiting Sri Lanka. The city was the last capital of the Sri Lankan kings and is a World Heritage site. There are many big-ticket attractions to be seen during your stay in Kandy. The world famous Peradeniya Botanical Gardens, Udawatta Kele sanctuary is famous for its extensive avifauna and adventurous bike rides, Kandy Lake which in the centre of the city, Bhairavakanda Buddha Statue, St. Paul's Church is located in the main city on sacred grounds west of the Temple of the Tooth, Hantana Mountain Range, Famous three temples located close to each other 20mts drive from Kandy, Exploring the local market and witnessing Traditional Kandy dancing, cultural shows are some activities to engage with. It is also the city to start your *scenic train ride* through the mountains. There are many day tours you can arrange from Kandy.
