WHALE WATCHING TOURS

- For several years, Sri Lanka has been able to boast being the world's top location to spot Blue Whales as well as Sperm Whales as they travel a long distance to warmer feeding grounds in the Bay of Bengal.
- Sperm Whales and Blue Whales are a common occurrence off the Southern Coast of Mirissa and Eastern coast of Trincomalee.
- South of Dondra Coast, the best time for whale watching is from November to April. In Trincomalee, the best time is from May to September as whales continue their migrations around the island from the south coast. Out of these months December, January and April are the peak months of sightings
- You can experience the largest mammals on earth in their natural habitat. You can often spot groups of spinner dolphins playing in the water during your tour. There is a 90 % chance of a blue whale sighting at the peak season.
